SELECTION OF ELECTIVE SUBJECTS **(CLASSES IX AND XI)**

Dear Parent,

This is with reference to the Public Notice No. CBSE.CE/Coordination dated 15 September 2025.

Following are the essential requirements for appearing in the Board examination conducted by the CBSE:

1. Classes X and XII are part of a two-year program comprising Class IX & X and Class XI & XII, respectively. Accordingly, all subjects should have studied for 2 years by a student to become eligible for appearing in the examinations.
2. Parents are requested to be careful while selecting elective subjects. Any change in elective subjects must be communicated to the class teacher by 6 September 2025 (Monday). Once the CBSE Registration is done in classes IX & XI, students cannot change their elective subjects in Class XI or XII.
3. Parents are requested to thoughtfully select the subject for their child in Class IX, including Hindi/Sanskrit and the Skill Subject. Once the choices are submitted in CBSE Registration, no changes can be made, so please make the decision wisely.
4. A minimum of five subjects must be taken in XI, and these subjects must be continued in Class XII. Students may also choose an additional elective (6th subject), which can be either a language or any other academic subject. If a student fails in any of the first five subjects, the 6th subject may replace the failed subject, provided that either Hindi or English remains as one of the main five subjects.

We advise parents to carefully select elective subjects. If there is any doubt, students may opt for a sixth subject as a safer option to ensure successful completion of the course.

Your cooperation in this regard is highly appreciated.
