



REPORT ON TEACHERS' AWARENESS SESSION ON FLN

A Teachers' Awareness Session on Foundational Literacy and Numeracy (FLN) was conducted to enhance teachers' understanding of the key goals, pedagogical approaches, and implementation strategies under the FLN Mission. The session highlighted the importance of early years as the base for future learning and focused on developing age-appropriate competencies in language, numeracy, and cognitive skills.

Teachers were introduced to play-based, activity-based, and experiential learning methods aligned with NCF and NEP 2020. Practical classroom strategies, including the use of learning materials, toy-based pedagogy, and continuous assessment techniques, were discussed. Interactive discussions and demonstrations enabled teachers to connect the concepts with real classroom practices.

The session concluded with teachers reflecting on current practices and identifying actionable steps to strengthen FLN outcomes in their classrooms. The whole hearted participation of teachers in KBC quiz (Kaun Banega collaborator) is applaudable.
