Purpose of the Workshop:

The purpose of this CBSE-recommended Capacity Building Program was to develop teachers' competencies in implementing toy-based pedagogy as part of experiential and activity-based learning. The workshop aimed to align teaching practices with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 by promoting learning through play, exploration, and hands-on experiences. The session focused on equipping teachers with practical methods to integrate educational toys and manipulatives into classroom teaching to enhance concept clarity and learner engagement.

Highlights of the Workshop:

Orientation on the concept, rationale and benefits of toy-based pedagogy. Demonstration of a variety of educational toys such as blocks, beads, puzzles, puppets and flashcards. Hands-on participation in activities including storytelling with puppets, pattern-making, sorting games and constructive play. Guidelines for designing toy-based activities for Language, Numeracy and EVS. Emphasis on holistic development—cognitive, motor, social, emotional and creative skills. Introduction to low-cost/no-cost toy-making using local materials. Group discussions encouraging teachers to share experiences and classroom challenges.



Reflection:

Participants found the session highly interactive and enriching. The workshop provided clear insights into how toys can make learning more child-centric, enjoyable, and meaningful. Teachers expressed that the practical demonstrations improved their confidence to incorporate play-based strategies into daily lesson plans. The session encouraged reflection on current practices and highlighted the importance of creating an inclusive, joyful, and experiential learning environment.
