**Earth Day celebration was initiated to motivate the students in saving the Earth from pollution, global warming, water scarcity and several other concerns.**








# Inter - House Kho Kho Tournament

Keeping this bonding emotion in mind, various activities were conducted on 9th May to celebrate 'Mother's Day'.



ON 16TH APRIL 2025, A WORKSHOP ON 'DECODE CUET' WAS ORGANIZED FOR CLASS XII STUDENTS IN THE SCHOOL AUDITORIUM TO PROVIDE DETAILED GUIDANCE AND INSIGHTS ON PREPARING FOR THE COMMON UNIVERSITY ENTRANCE TEST (CUET) FOLLOWING THE CBSE BOARD EXAMS. THE RESOURCE PERSON FOR THE WORKSHOP WAS MS. HEMA CHOUDHARY. THE SESSION COVERED KEY ASPECTS SUCH AS THE GROWING NUMBER OF UNIVERSITIES ACCEPTING CUET SCORES, THE EXAM'S STRUCTURE, TIMING, AND PAPER PATTERN, AS WELL AS SUBJECT COMBINATIONS FOR VARIOUS COURSES. THE IMPORTANCE OF SECTION 3 (GENERAL TEST) AND ITS ROLE IN ADMISSIONS, PARTICULARLY TO INSTITUTIONS LIKE THE UNIVERSITY OF DELHI, WAS ALSO DISCUSSED. ADDITIONALLY, THE WORKSHOP PROVIDED INSIGHTS INTO THE CSAS PORTAL, CUET 2023 RESULTS, CUTOFF TRENDS FOR TOP DU COLLEGES, AND EFFECTIVE PREPARATION STRATEGIES. 



