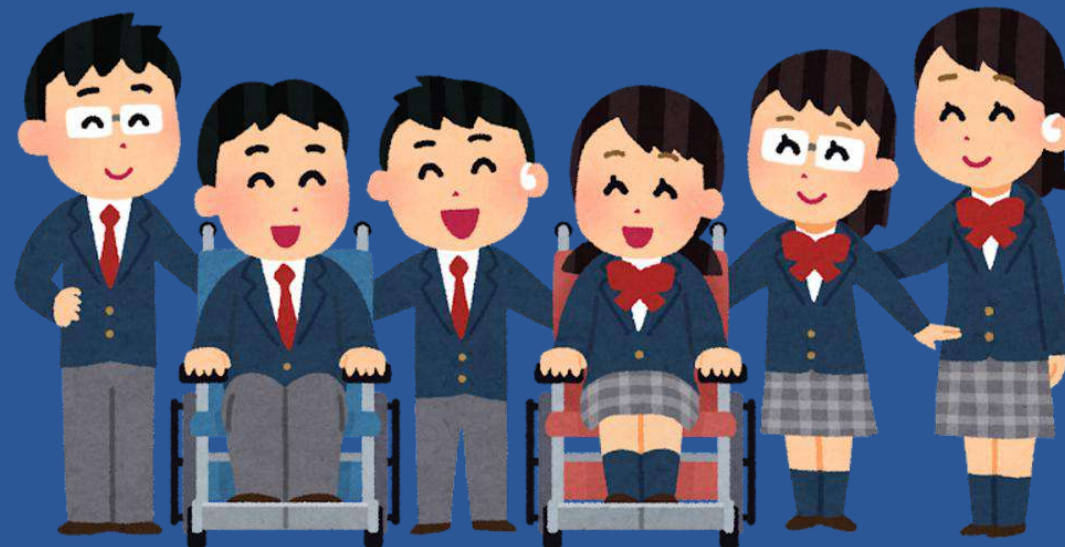
- **A total of 3 projects (one from each group) need to be done by a class 6 student during the academic year**

# key points for School Transport

## 1. Safety First

- Speed is regulated and drivers are trained.
- Buses are equipped with Cameras and GPS tracker.
- A Teacher/female attendant is present in the bus for student safety.

## 2. Verified Staff

- Drivers and attendants are police verified and trained to handle students responsibly.

## 3. Bus Timings

- Parents should ensure that students reach the stop 5 minutes before the scheduled time.

## 4. Bus Discipline

- Students must remain seated while the bus is moving.
- A daily attendance check is conducted in the bus at the time of boarding and deboarding.

## 5. Designated Bus Stops

- Students should board and deboard only at their assigned bus stop.

## 6. ID Card Requirement

- Students must carry their school ID card while travelling in the school bus.

## 7. Change in Transport

- Any temporary or permanent change in bus route or stop must be informed in writing to the principal.
