A JOYOUS CELEBRATION


Harshotsav, a special Pre-Nursery celebration, was a joyful reflection of experiential and holistic learning in alignment with NEP 2020.


The event beautifully showcased the enthusiastic participation of our little learners, providing them with an age-appropriate platform to express themselves confidently.

The celebration filled the school with joy, smiles, and festive cheer, making Diwali a memorable experience for our young learners.






