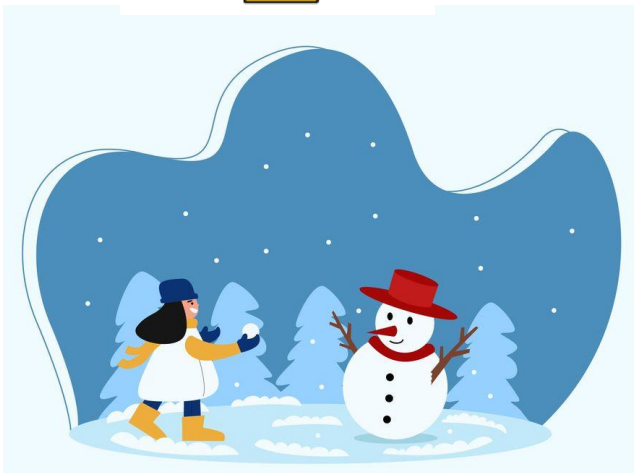

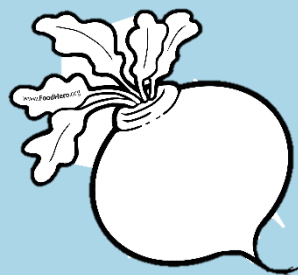

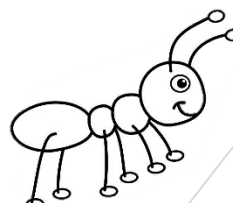


THE ANT AND THE PIGEON
